

Are you in the last 2 years of your full-time post-secondary study program?

The Department of Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour (PETL) may be able to assist you in receiving Employment Insurance (EI) benefits while you are attending university

If you were approved for EI benefits in the last year, please contact Gisèle Clément by e-mail at Gisele.Clement@gnb.ca or by telephone at (506) 856-2321.

If you have NOT received EI benefits while attending university in the past year, you must meet the following preliminary criteria for further consideration:

- You **must** possess a NB Medicare Card or be a member of a First Nations community
- You **must** be registered full-time in the last 2 years of your post-secondary study program

IF YOU MEET THE PRELIMINARY CRITERIA:

(Step 1) Please complete an application form. These forms are available at:

- PETL offices (office locations are indicated at the bottom of this sheet)
- Student Services Offices at Crandall University, Mount Allison University and l'Université de Moncton.

(Step 2) Please return the completed application form to the PETL office nearest your permanent residence. A PETL employee will communicate with you within two weeks of receipt of your application. (If your permanent address is outside of the counties of Westmorland, Kent or Albert, please contact the PETL Office in your region.) **PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL DOCUMENTS REQUESTED IN THE APPLICATION ARE ENCLOSED WITH YOUR APPLICATION, AS WELL AS A COPY OF YOUR MEDICARE CARD.**
