PART 1: An **official transcript** indicating your academic performance. The official transcript submitted for admission consideration can be used, however, ensure that your transcript includes the following:

- final grades for your first term courses.
- a list of courses that you are enrolled in for the second term.

PART 2 A separate summary for each of the following is required :

- **Leadership** (i.e., initiated project, elected office, director, sport's team captain),
- **Volunteerism** (i.e., high school and beyond high school activities that are community based),
- **Extracurricular Activities** (personal interest i.e., sports, band, arts, hobbies),
- **Work Experience** (i.e., paid, unpaid, internship)
- **Awards** (i.e., citizenship, academic, high school competitions) over the past 3 to 4 years.

For **Leadership**, **Volunteerism** and **Extracurricular Activities** please follow the outline below when making your separate summary for each of these three categories:

- *Name of each activity
- *Brief description of the activity
- *Your role in the activity (for example, leader, founder, participant, or employee)
- *What motivated you to get involved
- *Length of time you were involved in activity (for example, year(s), hours spent per week/month, or one-time experience)
- *Briefly discuss you experience (for example, what objectives were met)
- *Reference information (for example, contact information)

Under the **Work Experience** category include the following information:

- *Employer name
- *Job Description

- *Experience gained
- *Reference information (for example, contact information)

Under **Awards** include the following information:

- *Award name with brief description
- *Year awarded

PART 3: Reference letters from at least three different sources. One reference letter should be school-related and one should be community or volunteer related. Other reference letters can include work and extracurricular activities. Reference letters should be addressed to the Bell Scholarship Committee.

PART 4: A 500 word essay on *one* of the following topics:

"In your view what is the most significant challenge (political, financial, health-care, etc...) facing Canada in this decade and what solution(s) do you foresee that could help solve such challenges?"

OR

"Martin Luther King once said that "Our lives begin to end the day we are silent about things that matter." How does this statement relate to your own life?"
