The Leta G. Hill Scholarship was established by Charles Hill in loving memory of his wife, Leta. The award is valued at \$40,000 and is paid in four annual installments of \$10,000. In order to receive each annual installment, students must maintain a full course load of 30.0 credits and achieve a GPA of 3.0 over the fall and winter terms.

The scholarship is awarded to a student from **Nova Scotia**, with preference to students in Colchester County or East Hants County, who have demonstrated financial need and declare the intent to study medicine.

- A one page statement explaining why you wish to pursue a career in medicine.
- An official transcript indicating your academic performance. A photocopy of your official transcript that you submitted for admission consideration can be used, however, ensure that your transcript includes final grades for your first term courses. Include a list of courses that you are enrolled in for the second term.
