These scholarships were established by Herbert S. Sharp, Class of 1890 at Mount Allison, to be awarded to young men and women who were born in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, or Prince Edward Island, who are protestant, with preference given to members of the United Church of Canada and to applicants from Prince Edward Island. Recipients must declare that they will abstain from the use of tobacco in any form.

There is a strong financial need component to this award and students must have a recommendation from their minister. These \$2,000 scholarships are renewable for each year of study if the student maintains a GPA of 3.3 on a full course load.
