Students looking to apply to Mount Allison from Newfoundland and Labrador must have a calculable average of above 65% in ten credits in academic 3000 or 4000 level subjects. One of English language 3101, Thematic Literature 3201 or Literary Heritage 3202 must be included. When considering an applicant for admissions and scholarships, Mount Allison will assess the set of university-preparatory courses which most favour the student.
