

MAPPING YOUR DEGREE - Bachelor of Music Degree Requirements

Note: a minimum of 120 credits are required for a degree. A normal course load is 15 credits per term (in addition to music ensemble credits) for each of the Fall and Winter terms. Please refer to section 7.6 of the Academic Calendar for complete details of the Bachelor of Music degree. Please select the Degree Audit form that corresponds to the academic calendar you are following to complete your degree.

YEAR ONE (a student who has completed less than 24 credits is considered to be in Year One)

- You should be registered for the following core B.Mus. courses:
 - MUSC 1101: Materials of Music I (3 credits, Fall term)
 - MUSC 1201: Music History and Literature I (3 credits, Fall term)
 - MUSC 1501: Applied Music I (3 credits, Fall term)
 - MUSC 1111: Materials of Music II (3 credits, Winter term)
 - MUSC 1211: Music History and Literature II (3 credits, Winter term)
 - MUSC 1511: Applied Music II (3 credits, Winter term)(Since Departmental permission is required to register for these courses, the Music Department usually submits registration lists for them to the Registrar. You will likely find, therefore, that registration in these core courses is done for you.)
- In September you will have the opportunity to audition for one of the Music Department's ensembles, each of which is a 1-credit course. After ensemble placement is finalized, the Department will register you in your ensemble course. You do not register yourself in ensemble courses.
- You should register for 6 credits of non-Music elective courses each term.

YEAR TWO: (a student who has successfully completed 24 credits is considered to be in Year Two)

- You should register for the following core B.Mus. courses (assuming you have acquired the pre-requisites):
 - MUSC 2101: Materials of Music III (3 credits, Fall term)
 - MUSC 2201: Music History and Literature III (3 credits, Fall term)
 - MUSC 2501: Applied Music (3 credits, Fall term)
 - MUSC 2111: Materials of Music IV (3 credits, Winter term)
 - MUSC 2211: Music History and Literature IV (3 credits, Winter term)
 - MUSC 2511: Applied Music (3 credits, Winter term)
- In September you will have the opportunity to audition for one of the Music Department's ensembles, each of which is a 1-credit course. After ensemble placement is finalized, the Department will register you in your ensemble course. You do not register yourself in ensemble courses.
- You should register for 6 credits of Music or non-Music elective courses, for which you have pre-requisites, each term. (If your principle instrument is keyboard [piano or organ], you should register for MUSC 2603: Collaborative Keyboard I [3 credits Fall and Winter terms] as one of these electives.)
- Note: if your course selection for non-Music electives satisfies the requirements for a Minor, the Minor will be recorded on your transcript. If declaring a Minor, please complete a "Declaration/Addition/Change of Major or Minor form available on the web at <http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms.html> .

YEAR THREE: (a student who has successfully completed 54 credits is considered to be in Year Three)

- You should register for the following core B.Mus. course (assuming you have acquired the pre-requisite):
 - MUSC 3501/3511: Applied Music (3 credits, Fall and Winter terms)
- In September you will have the opportunity to audition for one of the Music Department's ensembles, each of which is a 1-credit course. After ensemble placement is finalized, the Department will register you in your ensemble. You do not register yourself ensemble courses.
- You should register for 12 credits of Music or non-Music elective courses, for which you have pre-requisites, each term.
- Note: if your course selection for non-Music electives satisfies the requirements for a Minor, the Minor will be recorded on your transcript. If declaring a Minor, please complete a "Declaration/Addition/Change of Major or Minor form available on the web at <http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms.html> .

YEAR FOUR: (a student who has successfully completed 84 credits is considered to be in Year Four)

- You should register for **one** of the following core B.Mus. courses (assuming you have acquired the pre-requisites):
 - MUSC 4501/4511: Applied Music IV (3 credits each, Fall and Winter terms), or
 - MUSC 4601/4611: Collaborative Keyboard (3 credits each, Fall and Winter terms), or
 - MUSC 4581: Credited Shared Recital (6 credits, Winter term), or
 - MUSC 4591: Credited Full Recital (6 credits, Winter term), or
- In September you will have the opportunity to audition for one of the Music Department's ensembles, each of which is a 1-credit course. After ensemble placement is finalized, the Department will register you in your ensemble course. You do not register yourself ensemble courses.
- You should register for 12 credits of Music or non-Music elective courses, for which you have pre-requisites, each term.
- Note: if you intend to graduate in May, you must complete an **Application for Graduation and Degree Audit form by September 30**. Forms are available on the web at <http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms.html> .
- Your registration **must** include **both** Fall and Winter terms, for **all** courses that are required to complete degree requirements.
