

2011-2012 MAPPING YOUR DEGREE - Bachelor of Fine Arts Degree Requirements

Note: 120 credits are required for a Bachelor of Fine Arts degree. A normal course load is 15 credits per term for each of the Fall and Winter terms. Please refer to section [11.7](#) of the Academic Calendar for complete details of the Bachelor of Fine Arts degree (http://www.mta.ca/academic_dept/calendar.html). YEAR ONE (a student who has completed fewer than 24 credits is considered to be in Year One)

- ▶ you should register for Fine Arts Studio courses, Art History courses and non-Fine Arts electives as outlined under Year One in section [11.7.4](#) of the Academic Calendar. You will be pre-registered in all of your Fine Arts Studio courses.
- ▶ Note: if your course selection for non-Fine Arts electives satisfies the requirements for a Minor, (excluding Minors in Fine Arts or Art History) the Minor will be recorded on your transcript. If declaring a Minor, please complete a 'Declaration/Addition /Change of Major or Minor' form available on the web at http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms/major_minor_app.html

YEAR TWO (a student who has successfully completed 24 credits is considered to be in Year Two)

- ▶ you should register for Fine Arts Studio courses, Art History courses and non-Fine Arts electives as outlined under Year Two in section [11.7.4](#) of the Academic Calendar.
- ▶ Note: if your course selection for **non-Fine Arts** electives satisfies the requirements for a Minor(excluding Minors in Fine Arts or Art History), the Minor will be recorded on your transcript. If declaring a Minor, please complete a 'Declaration/Addition /Change of Major or Minor' form available on the web at http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms/major_minor_app.html.

YEAR THREE (a student who has successfully completed 54 credits is considered to be in Year Three)

- ▶ you should register for Fine Arts Studio courses, Art History courses and non-Fine Arts electives as outlined under Year Three in section [11.7.4](#) of the Academic Calendar.
- ▶ Note: if your course selection for non-Fine Arts electives satisfies the requirements for a Minor (excluding Minors in Fine Arts or Art History), the Minor will be recorded on your transcript. If declaring a Minor, please complete a 'Declaration/Addition /Change of Major or Minor' form available on the web at http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms/major_minor_app.html.

YEAR FOUR (a student who has successfully completed 84 credits is considered to be in Year Four)

- ▶ you should register for Fine Arts Studio courses, Art History courses and non-Fine Arts electives as outlined under Year Four in section [11.7.4](#) of the Academic Calendar.
- ▶ if you intend to graduate in May, you must complete an **Application for Graduation form by September 30th and Degree Audit form by October 30th**. (Forms are available on the web at http://www.mta.ca/administration/sas/forms/grad_app.html)
- ▶ You **MUST** register for **both** the Fall and Winter terms, for **all** courses that are required to complete degree requirements.
