At Mount Allison you will learn to become an engaged, global citizen who sees beyond borders. The University offers 17 programs in 14 countries around the world, including semester-long, year-long, and summer programs.

Study Abroad

Mount Allison's study-abroad programs offer you the option of short-term studies on an individual basis or as part of a group. Programs vary in length from three weeks to as long as twelve weeks — typically during the spring and summer months. The programs are set up in a number of ways. You will either be expected to pay tuition at Mount Allison, an all-inclusive fee, or pay the host institution directly.

All of the concepts and theories that are taught in the classrooms at Mount Allison came to life on the streets and in the neighborhoods of India.”

Exchange

In Mount Allison's exchange programs you can attend classes at an officially recognized partner institution in a foreign country. In return, Mount Allison agrees to receive a student from the same partner institution. This is generally for one semester or an entire academic year. Exchange students pay tuition directly to Mount Allison. All other charges, including housing, meals, and textbooks, are paid directly to the host university.

Living in a country where I had a limited grasp of the language and culture was certainly difficult, but there was no shortage of people willing to help me out. It was life-changing.”
