

The Music Department at Mount Allison University invites applications for the position of instructor in Cello. This is a stipendiary (part-time) appointment. Preference will be given to applicants with degrees and/or diplomas in cello performance, an established record as a performer, and studio teaching experience at the university level. Teaching responsibilities include weekly studio instruction in cello of 1 student (MUSC 3501-11), approximately 1 hour per week, overseeing student performance preparation, and assessing performance juries associated with this student. These courses run for both Fall and Winter semesters: September 2018 to April 2019. Courses will be taught on the campus of Mount Allison University. Application materials should include a letter of interest, an up-to-date curriculum vitae, and recordings of recent solo performances. Applicants should provide the names and contact information of at least three referees. Applications should be sent to the address below. Electronic submissions are preferred.
