Evaluate Three Ideas for a Side Hustle

Now that you have your potential side hustle ideas, it's time to evaluate them to find the possibility that's best for you.

Using the following table, rate each of your three ideas in terms of the three Ps:

- How pleasurable is the idea?
- How possible is it?
- How profitable is it?

Score each idea across each of the three Ps using a scale of 1 to 5. Then calculate your total score to find your winning idea.

Notes:

1. Just as everyone has different side hustle goals, everyone is going to have different side hustle values. You may need to adjust your score sheet to reflect your personal values.

For example, if you place a high value on profitability, then it should account for more of your idea's score. Add two points to profitability and take 1 point away from the other two P's.

Possible = /4
Profit = /7

2. If each of your ideas rates 13/15 or higher, be more critical. If two ideas tie for the highest score, pick the one that has the higher pleasure value – you'll thank yourself later!
