

## Adding Questions to the Survey of the Student Experience of Courses

The Senate Report on Revision of Policy 5310 (February 13, 2018) suggests the questions below may be added to the printed or electronic form. ### I. Questions strongly recommended by PCTC to improve and refine teaching practice and support teaching award applications:

- a. I found this **course** intellectually challenging and stimulating.
- b. I learned and understood the subject matter of this **course**.
- c. The workload in this **course** was reasonable and appropriate.
- d. **Course materials** were well prepared and carefully explained
- e. Methods of **assessing** student feedback were fair and appropriate.
- f. **Feedback** on assessments /graded work was valuable.
- g. The teacher seemed enthusiastic about teaching the course.
- h. The **teacher** encouraged students to share their own ideas and ask questions.
- i. The **teacher** was adequately accessible to students during office hours or after class.
- j. Overall, this professor is an effective university **teacher**. *[Note that this question has been reworded slightly.]*

### II. Questions strongly recommended by MASU:

- The classroom environment was respectful and inclusive. (similar to h above)
- Methods of assessing student work were fair and appropriate. (same as e above)
- Overall, this professor is an effective university teacher. (same as j above)

Numbers 7-16 of the Survey of the Student Experience of Courses have been provided to add questions. The questions strongly recommended by MASU and PCTC should be inserted starting with Question 7. The answer categories will be on a 5-point Likert scale from strongly disagree to strongly agree.”
