

# Configure Wireless for iOS

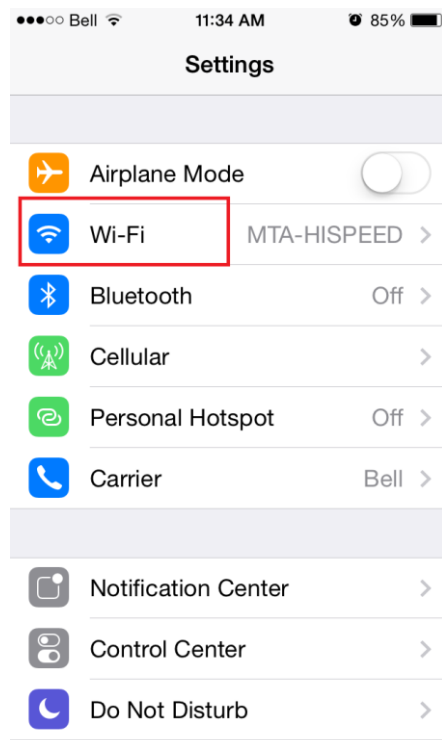
*This document is meant to help you to connect your iPhone, iPod or iPad to MTA's Wireless networks. When visiting another participating institution, you can connect your laptop to Eduroam.*

## Configure Wireless on an iPhone or iPod Touch

1. Tap the **Settings** application (located directly on the home screen by default).

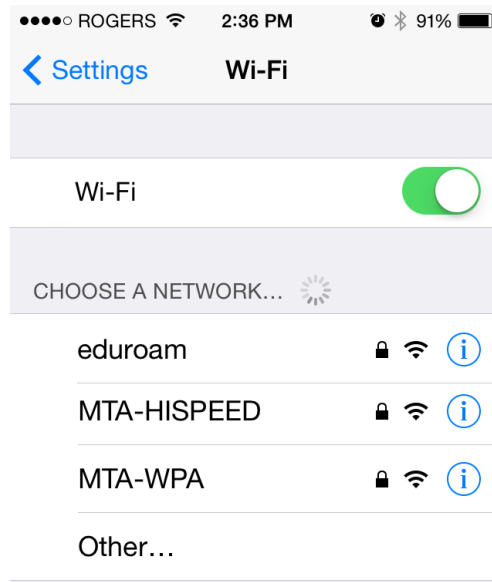


2. Select **Wi-Fi**.

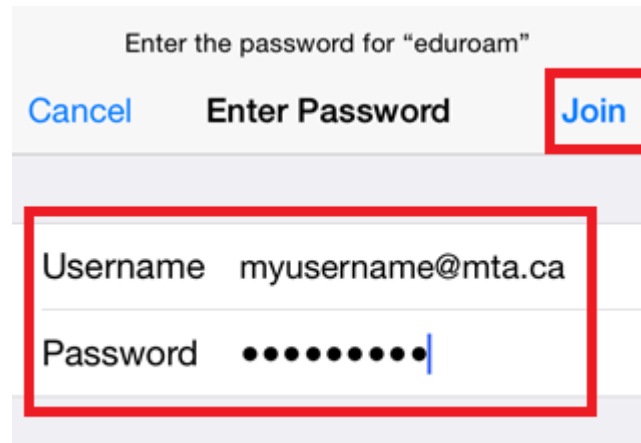


3. Ensure that Wi-Fi is turned ON then select one of the following networks:

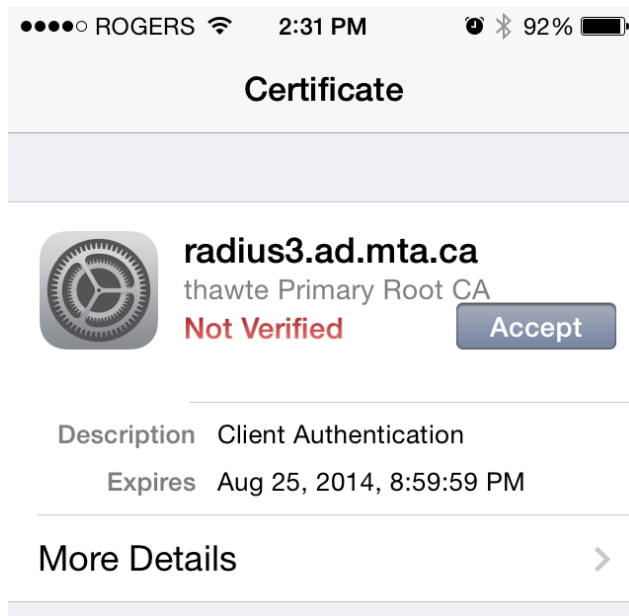
- **MTA-HISPEED**
- **MTA-WPA**
- **eduroam** (for non-MTA users visiting MTA and MTA users visiting another participating institution).



4. Enter your username followed by @mta.ca (**userid@mta.ca**) in the Username field. This is normally your e-mail address. Enter your **password** in the Password field. Tap **Join**.



5. If your credentials are valid, a certificate will be displayed; it should look like this:



6. Tap **Accept**.

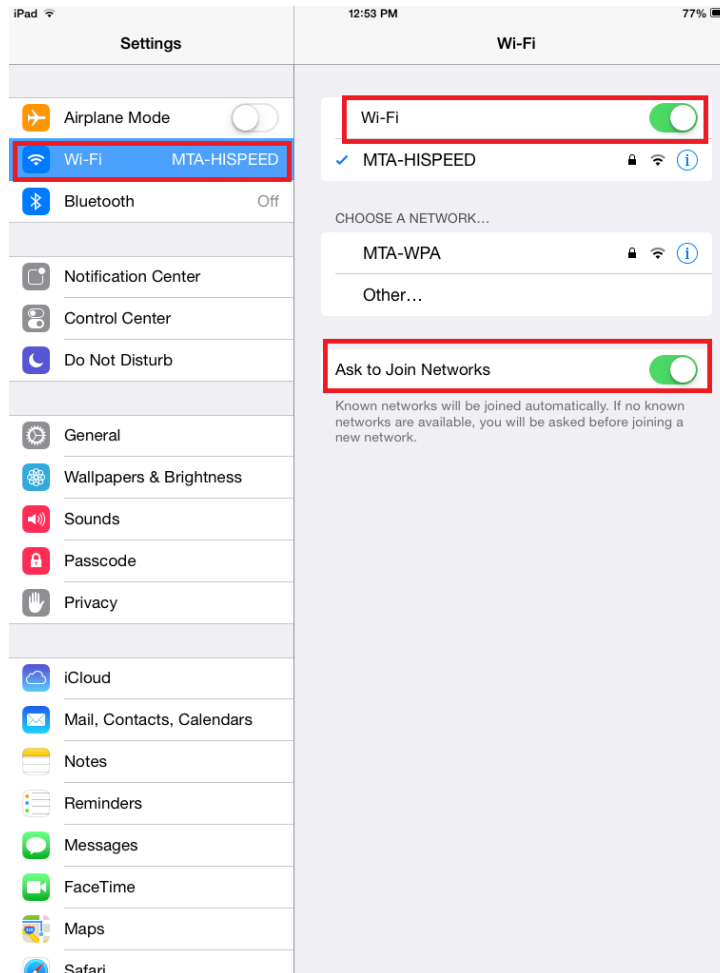
Your iPhone or iPod should now be connected to Eduroam (or to the MTA wireless network you have entered / selected).

## Configure Wireless on an iPad

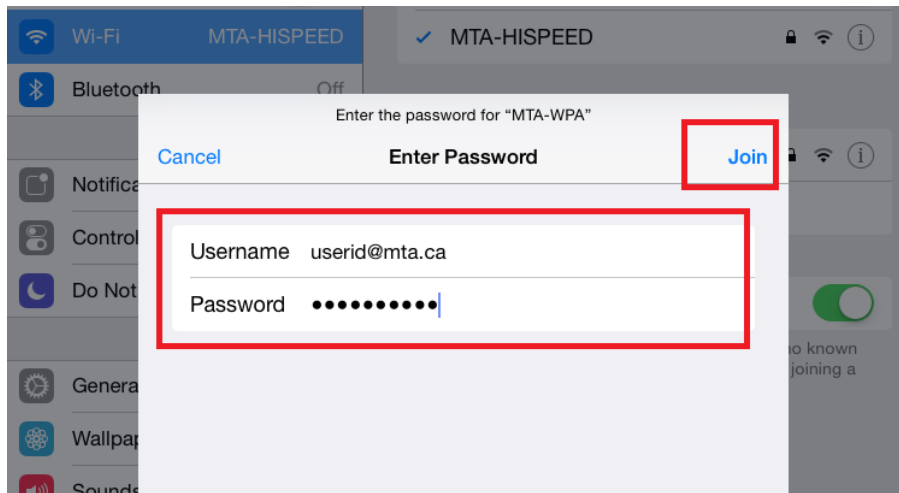
1. On the Home screen, tap **Settings**.



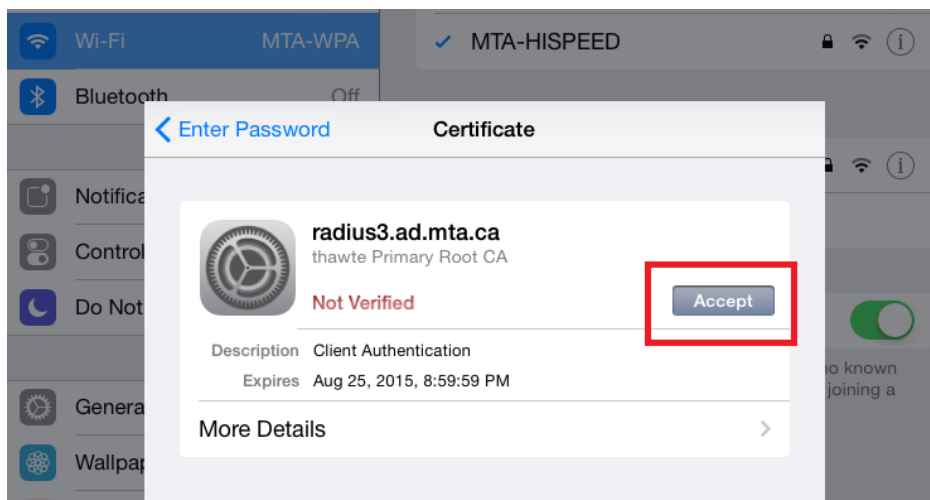
2. Select **Wi-Fi** and make sure that Wi-Fi and **Ask to Join Networks** are toggled **On**.  
If not, tap the appropriate OFF/ON toggle.



3. Choose one of the following wireless networks):
  - **MTA-HISPEED**
  - **MTA-WPA**
  - **eduroam** (for non-MTA users visiting MTA and MTA users visiting another participating institution).
  
4. Enter your username followed by @mta.ca (**userid@mta.ca**) in the Username field. This is normally your e-mail address. Enter your **password** in the Password field. Tap **Join**.



5. Click **Accept** for the **thawte Primary Root CA** certificate.



Your iPad should now be connected to Eduroam (or to the MTA wireless network you have entered / selected).
